

HOW TO WEAR A MINISKIRT

Style expert Danna Weiss swears anyone can do it

- LENGTH IS KEY For the most flattering look, the hem should hit no shorter than 2 inches below the curve of the rear end and no longer than midthigh.
- DO A SIT TEST
 When trying on a mini, sit down: The bum should touch fabric, not the seat.
- BALANCE IT OUT
 Offset an overtly sexy style with a long-sleeve top.
- LOW HEELS ARE BETTER
 Flats keep the look sweet.
 But if the event calls
 for heels, keep hair and
 makeup conservative.
 And stay away from
 all boots except nude
 ankle boots, which visually
 elongate legs.
- FAKE PERFECT PINS
 Mask scars, veins and blemishes with a self-tanner, or try nude fishnet stockings.
